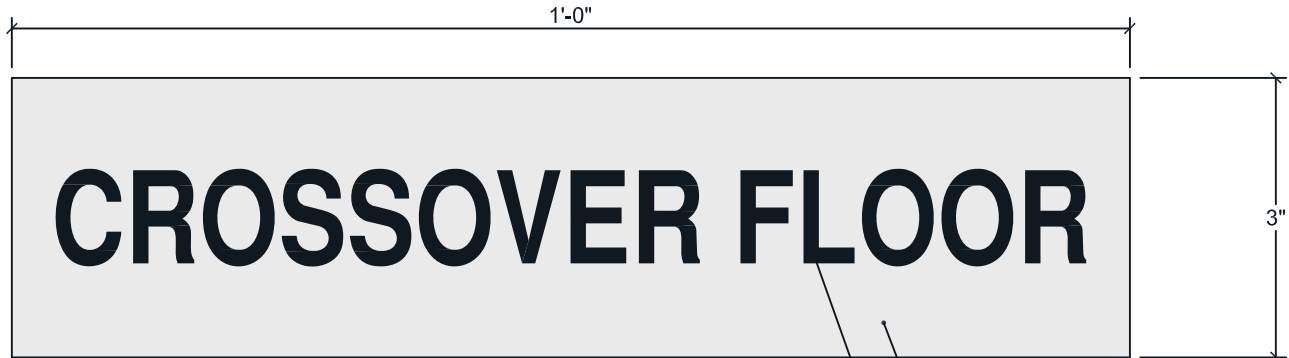


## CROSSOVER FLOOR SIGN

### ONTARIO BUILDING CODE

#### 3.4.6.18. EMERGENCY ACCESS TO FLOOR AREAS

The Building Code requires that in a building over 6 storeys, emergency access is required to be provided out of an exit stairwell to permit people to leave the stairwell and enter a floor area, should the stairwell become blocked by smoke or other obstructions above the exit level. Signs are required to indicate which doors within the exit stairs will provide emergency access to the floor areas.

The signs are required to be mounted on the stairway side of those doors which the Building Code requires not to have locking devices that would prevent entry. Those doors are into:

- any floor area designated as an area of refuge;
- at least one door every five storeys or less;
- at least one of the three highest storeys.
